The Gulu offers one of the most varied selections of food, beer, and atmosphere of any location in Salem. Be warned though: if you are looking for your standard Budweiser or Coors Light you'll quickly realize you are in the wrong place. On the other hand, if you are looking for the most diverse and palatable selection of beers in Salem, you've found it! The Ommegang *Three Philosophers*, *Unibroue La Fin Du Monde*, *Weihenstephaner Vitus...* you'll need a week of visits to try half of their list, which has an astounding 40 selections! 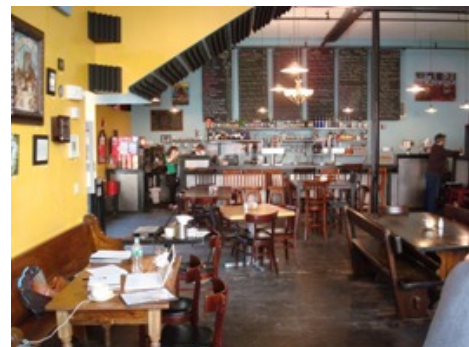
